DIRECTOR'S UPDATE:

Nine years ago, we held our first informational meeting for HHHR at the local community center. Approx 25 people came to hear my heart and my dream for HHHR. After many closed doors (Little did we know God had just the right property for us), additional meetings, non profit paperwork, finding board members, patience, tears, and the list goes on, God brought us to this location in 2017. A group of kids and adults built the fence by hand. Slowly every year we started to grow. Then God opened some big doors for us this summer and allowed us to build this barn. We are currently \$7,000 short but trust that God will continue to fill in the gap and provide the funds in addition to funds for the electricity. Our vision for the barn is to keep animals warm in the winter, have a place for kids to hang out when the weather doesn't cooperate, an office, handicap bathroom (currently pay \$170/month for a port a potty), area for merchandise, and small kitchen area.
